TOPIC: SUNSHINE COAST REGIONAL ATHLETICS CARNIVAL 2010

1. REGIONAL CARNIVAL

The carnival will be held at:

Sunshine Coast University – Athletics Facility.

Times: **Wednesday 1st September, 8.00am - 3.25pm.**

A tuck-shop will operate.

Districts should be aware of the Sun Safety Policy Guidelines and Hydration Guidelines.

Districts are required to bring their own shade and ensure athletes have appropriate headwear and sunscreen and water.

2. COST FACTORS

A regional **Nomination Fee** of \$ 12.10 (GST inclusive) per student will be charged.

Therefore, each District should collect a fee of \$11.00 (GST exclusive) from each student. This money should then be banked at the District Treasurer's school.

The Regional Sports Office will invoice each District Treasurer's school for an amount equal to \$12.10 x no. of students in the District Team.

3. Each District is responsible for supplying suitably qualified Officials as requested. (See list attached). Official's names and job allocation should accompany District nominations.

4. FIELD EVENTS AND 800m

Two nominations per event. Special circumstances regarding a third nomination for any **field event** will be considered, if such circumstances would seem to warrant this inclusion in a particular event. **Convenors would require earliest notification of any such instance.** Final decision to be made by the Convenor in consultation with the Regional Sports Officer.

5. TRACK EVENTS

Three nominations per event. There will be three (3) heats to be run on the day. In the 100m events the nine (9) fastest heat times will progress to the final and in the 200m events the eight (8) fastest heat times will progress to the final.

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6. MULTI EVENT

Districts are able to nominate one athlete per age group (10, 11, 12 Boys & Girls) for the multi-event which will consist of 100m, 800m, Shot Put and Long Jump.

Athletes nominated for the multi-event must have qualified for at least one of the list events on merit and preferably two or more.

Athletes can be in individual events and the multi-event. This is the situation at the State and National Championships.

One athlete per age group in Boys and Girls will be selected to represent the Region at the State Championships in Townsville on 15 & 16 October.

If an athlete is already nominated for an event, which is also part of the multi-event, their time in the heat (track) and best of three attempts (field) will count towards their points score.

A separate multi-event will be run for athletes not nominated for individual 100m and 800m events.

In the field events, Shot Put and Long Jump, any extra multi-event athletes will join the existing programmed event. No separate multi-event will be conducted.

REMINDER: A multi-event athlete who competes in an event for selection as the multi-event nomination is **ineligible** for selection in an individual event which he/she did not qualify for at the District Carnival irrespective of their placing in the event at the Regional Trial. e.g. If an athlete does not qualify for the 100m at their District Carnival and runs in the 100m at

the

Regional Trial for selection in the multi-event, they are ineligible for selection in the individual 100m race irrespective of where he / she places.

- a) Competitors will be permitted to compete in their own age group **only** e.g. A 10 year old **CANNOT** compete in an event for an 11 year old. There are **no** events for 9 years old students.
- b) Ages are calculated according to year of birth. e.g. A child born in 1998 is a 12 year old in 2010.
- c) Entries **CLOSE** with the Regional Sports Office on Wednesday 18 August 2010 at 9.00am. Late entries may not be accepted.
- d) Only children born 1998, 1999 and 2000 are eligible for selection in the Regional Team.

NOMINATIONS

The use of an electronic Program (Meet Manager) will be provided to Districts to nominate their Athletics Team if the District does not already have this.
This program will also be used to produce the Regional Trial Program of Events.

PLEASE CONTACT THE REGIONAL SCHOOL SPORT OFFICE IMMEDIATELY UPON RECEIPT OF THIS NOTICE TO PROVIDE THE NAME AND CONTACT DETAILS OF THE PERSON WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COLLATING AND FORWARDING THE DISTRICT'S NOMINATIONS.

FOOTWEAR

It is strongly recommended that athletes competing on the tartan track in any events wear appropriate footwear.

If athletes do not have suitable shoes, it is further recommended that athlete's feet are taped before they compete. Athletes needing to have their feet strapped by a Sports Medicine Trainer on the day must provide their own strapping tape. However, there may be time constraints depending on the number of athletes requiring strapping so it is advised that athlete's feet are strapped before they arrive at the Trial venue.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Students invited to join the Regional Team to attend the State Championships in Townsville will be requested to make private travel arrangements. There are a very limited number of seats available on the Team official's flight. These are accessible on a "first-in" basis.

Sunshine Coast Region - Primary Athletics - 2010

General Information

1. Competitors may compete in their own age groups only. e.g. a 10 year old may not compete in an event for 11 year olds.
2. There will be no substitutions accepted. Only athletes nominated by the District are eligible to compete.
3. Ages are calculated according to year of birth.
4. The use of running shoes will only be permitted, as with starting blocks, in 100m and 200m Sprints. They must only be worn just prior to and during the event. Immediately the event is finished, competitors must remain in their lane, remove their running shoes and await instructions from the Officials. Spikes may be allowed in Long Jump and in High Jump events if appropriate mats are available.
FLOP JUMP MATS ONLY WILL BE USED IN ALL HIGH JUMP EVENTS.
5. Shoes must be worn by all competitors in Shot Put and Discus.
6. A "False Start" will be indicated by two quick starting pistol shots, and such will serve as the signal for recall and a further start. In the event of a "miss-fire", a whistle blast will serve as the "False Start", and subsequent recall.
The second False start per athlete may result in disqualification.
7. Individual Age Champions (Boys and Girls) will be awarded trophies.
8. In the 100m Events, the nine (9) fastest runners from the heats will progress to the Final.
In the 200m Events, the eight (8) fastest runners from the heats will progress to the Final.
9. The selection of children for the Sunshine Coast Regional Team, to compete in the 2010 Q.P.S. Track and Field State Championships in Townsville on 15 & 16 October will be made by selectors appointed for that purpose.
In the main, there will be three (3) nominations for each Individual Event at State, and one nomination for each Relay Event – provided qualifying standards have been met.
Variations to this will be four (4) nominations in the 100m events and two (2) nominations in the multi-event.
10. **REMINDER:** A multi-event athlete who competes in an event for selection as the multi-event nomination is **ineligible** for selection in an individual event which he/she did not qualify for at the District Carnival irrespective of their placing in the event at the Regional Trial.

11. REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP:

The Regional Track & Field Carnival will be conducted as a Regional Championship and a Perpetual Shield will be presented to the winning Districts in Aggregate and Percentage Divisions.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Top eight (8) competitors in all events. - 5 Points

Additional points will be awarded for the first three (3) place-getters as follows.

10 for first **6** for second **4** for third.

No points will be awarded for students nominated as Additional Competitors.

Team Manager's Information

1. Competitors for all events are to report to their Team Managers no later than **8.15am** on **Wednesday 1st September.**
2. To enter the Oval Competition Area, competitors will be called through the Public Address system. Competitors **MUST THEN** move quickly to the nominated Assembly Areas.
3. All competitors must wear their appropriate District colours.
4. Competitors are to remain in their lanes upon the completion of all Sprints until the Judge requests competitors to leave lanes.
5. LANE POSITIONS shall be as per Program for heats, whilst finals lanes will be as per a lane draw with the fastest qualifiers running in the middle lanes.
6. Event times are indicated on the Program of Events, but are approximate only. It is considered a Competitor and Team Manager responsibility to follow Event Times as a guide, and to be prepared for "Event Calls" irrespective, as the Program will run on a continuous basis.

Breaks in the Program will be indicated over the P.A. System.

Team Managers are requested to consult the Carnival Referee/s should any matter of dispute arise, i.e. immediately.

7. Consideration will be given to requests for exemption for students who are unable to compete at the Regional Trials as long as the reason for the request meets the eligibility for selection policy criteria (see in Program). Requests for exemption must be received prior to the day of the Trials. No requests will be accepted on the day of the Trials. A request for exemption does not guarantee selection in the Regional Team. An athlete's results from his / her District Trial will be the major basis for consideration for selection.
8. All Team Managers are reminded of \$11.00 Nomination Fee per competitor to be paid to the District Treasurer's school. Each District will advise Team Managers how this money is to be collected.
